I. Minutes:

A motion to accept the minutes was made by Ann Marie Mastroianni and seconded by Chris Prue to accept the minutes of May 2021. The motion passed with one abstention.

IV. Committee Reports:

Legislative-

- Nothing significant passed. SB5 will be put into the budget implementer.
- Day of birth must be redacted prior to giving out a requested list.
- The Senate chair won't allow any ROVAC bill to be put forward calling it a "lobbyist bill". We are working with Rep. Fox to get our tech bill into the implementer, as well.
- Early voting will be on the ballot in 2022 and no-fault absentee voting will be on the ballot in 2024.
- Redistricting information should be received by September. Local districts will have to be completed prior to the November Election.
- As of now, there is no COVID extension. Since SB5 did not pass, we can't use the white drop boxes for Abs.
- Only bad part of SB5, 4th Tuesday prior to an election, Registrars must reach out to the high schools to show students how to register to vote.

V. New Business:

- The fall conference will be in person, September 23-24 in Southbury. A motion by Annalisa Stravato and seconded by Ann Marie Mastroianni. The motion passed unanimously.
- Sue Larsen thanked the executive board for their hard work.
